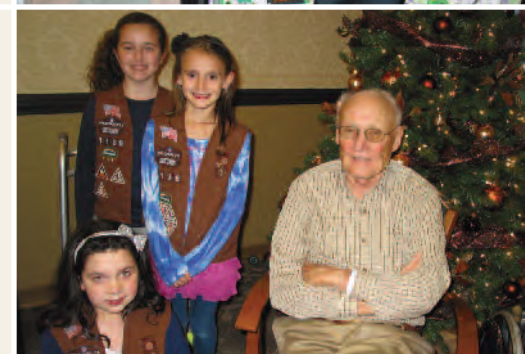

COMMUNITY BENEFITS

Expanding the Definition of Caring for the Community

As part of its non-profit mission, Christian Health Care Center (CHCC) is committed not only to its core businesses of mental health and elder care, but also to keeping the community-at-large healthy. The Center uses its resources and energy to continually evaluate and strive to meet the varied needs of the community, whether the community is across town, across the state, or across the country.

Joan Katz, RD, enjoys sharing nutrition knowledge with community members of all ages.

CHCC employees and volunteers address community needs through anticipated – and sometimes unexpected – ways. Among other activities, they conduct blood-pressure screenings and flu clinics at health fairs; help ensure equitable health care and protection of patient rights through advocacy efforts on local, state, and national levels; care for the environment by promoting “green” efforts; and provide education through lectures.

For example, Joan Katz, RD, CHCC Nutrition Services Director, enthusiastically and readily shares her nutrition knowledge with community members of all ages. Toddlers, teenagers, baby boomers, and seniors have all benefitted from her nutrition know-how.

“I just love speaking in the community,” says Mrs. Katz, who makes several presen-

tations every month. “Sometimes I get speaking engagements through word of mouth. Other times I’ll approach a group myself. If I see a sign for a senior meeting I’ll call and ask if they’d like a presentation on senior nutrition.”

Mrs. Katz views her speaking engagements as opportunities to help people understand how proper nutrition affects all areas of their lives. She’ll often relay valuable information about foods and vitamins in relation to age.

“With seniors I always promote the value of being well-hydrated, eating a lot of cultured products which are good for the gastrointestinal and immune systems, and taking a good multi-vitamin,” she says. “I also emphasize ‘super foods’ that give the best bang for the nutrition buck. These include salmon, oatmeal, berries, dark-green leafy



vegetables, and nuts, which are absolutely marvelous sources of protein and mono-unsaturated fats.”

While Mrs. Katz “gives” through sharing her knowledge, she also receives from those who attend her presentations.

“I love hearing stories, especially from seniors. I love hearing what was served for Sunday dinner and how beans were the main source of protein during war time,” she says. “Going out into the community is invigorating. It keeps me on my toes and reminds me how lucky I am to have my home base at CHCC. It’s about giving back. That’s how my husband and I raised our children and that’s how we live our lives.”
