2011 WAS A MONUMENTAL YEAR in the history of Christian Health Care Center.

A century ago, 14 deacons from the Reformed tradition made a commitment to elevate the care of the mentally ill. They vowed to build a facility – the first private psychiatric hospital in the state of New Jersey – that would provide compassionate, high-quality, and effective care for the mind, body, and spirit based on Christian principles. One hundred years later, Christian Health Care Center has grown to include a broad spectrum of long-term care, mental-health care, and residential living on 78 acres in Wyckoff and Hawthorne, with a satellite location in Wayne.

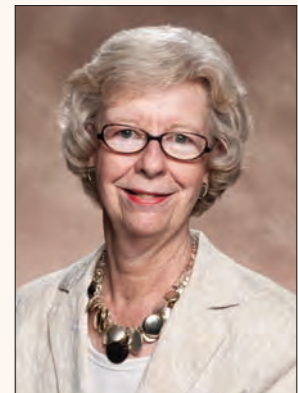

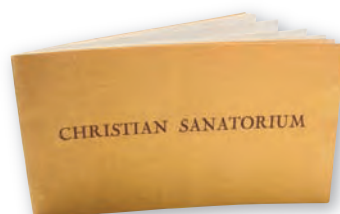
