

# 2013 in review

What is Christian Health Care Center (CHCC)? Decades ago it focused solely on providing mental-health care for adults. Today, CHCC is a multifaceted organization focusing on compassionate health, healing, and wellness for all ages. From child day care to outpatient adolescent counseling, adult partial-hospitalization, and skilled nursing for seniors, CHCC can provide care throughout a person's lifespan.

The events of 2013 illustrate our success in delivering care across the generations. They illustrate our commitment to exceeding the expectations of those entrusted to our care. Additionally, they confirm our dedication to extending care beyond our walls by caring for communities across town, across the country, and across the world.

## january

Nearly 400 people attended **Christian Health Care Center Foundation's first Beefsteak at the Brownstone** in Paterson, which raised more than \$41,000, for The Longview Assisted Living Residence. The football-themed event featured a special presentation by Juan Paul Gonzalez, a New Jersey high school teacher and founder of the Christian basketball organization 4-One. His "all in" motivational speech to the NY Giants on Christmas Eve 2011 is credited with helping the team stay focused on their way to winning Super Bowl XLVI.

Christian Health Care Center's first **Undergraduate Summer Internship Program** attracted 11 college students.

The CHCC Board of Trustees elected **Eugene Chrinian** and **Bernie Tolsma Jr.** as new members. **Mark Reitsma** returned to the board after retiring from the board for a year, and **Henry Driesse** and **Daniel Grimm** were re-elected.

## july

The **Longview Assisted Living Residence** was granted Advanced Standing Status by the New Jersey Department of Health and the Health Care Association of New Jersey Foundation. Longview received the status for its dedication to quality and for successfully complying with all state, federal, and local regulations.

CHCC entered into an agreement with PSE&G to receive more than **\$2.3 million of grant funding** over the next year for the acquisition and installation of more energy-efficient replacement equipment throughout campus.

Pastoral Care launched a **Parish Nurse Ministry Forum** to provide an opportunity for parish nurses and other church leaders interested in parish health ministry to meet, network, and interact on a topic of interest relevant to their work.



## october


