CHCC's medical staff and extensive team of doctors continue to work alongside the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to ensure safe vaccine distribution following all recommendations and guidelines. We are looking forward to our upcoming distribution of the vaccine, and doing our part to further safeguard our residents, patients, staff, and ultimately beyond to our community from COVID-19.
