Guided by our faith and strengthened by collaboration, we remained unwavering in our commitment to compassionate care, innovation, and service to the communities that place their trust in us.

Throughout the year, our tradition of excellence in care continued across our organization. Christian Health was recognized among America’s Best Nursing Homes by Newsweek, ranking No. 2 in New Jersey in the “Over 150 Beds” category for the sixth consecutive year. In addition, we were named among the nation’s best nursing homes by U.S. News and World Report for the third consecutive year.

Christian Health also received Customer Experience Awards from Activated Insights, ranking among the top 100 of more than 1,800 organizations nationwide. These recognitions reflect our commitment to resident and patient experience, clinical outcomes, and safety practices, supported by the extraordinary dedication, compassion, and professionalism of our team.

In 2025, we took an important step forward with the launch of our SPRAVATO® (esketamine) treatment program for individuals living with treatment-resistant depression. As the first hospital-based program of its kind in northern New Jersey, this initiative represents the best of both worlds, combining clinical excellence with a comforting outpatient setting. We remain deeply committed to meeting the complex behavioral health needs of our community through advanced, evidence-based therapies that offer hope to those who have struggled to find relief.

We also continue to grow stronger through the relationships that define us. Our integration with NewBridge Services enables us to provide a more comprehensive range of care and reach more individuals throughout the community. In addition, thanks to the generosity of our supporters, we are making meaningful improvements to our campus. In 2025, we advanced plans for a new patio outside the Gracepoint Partial-Hospitalization and Intensive Outpatient Program, began extensive renovations to our Plant Operations building, and initiated the Heritage Manor East Capital Project, a multi-year renovation of our skilled nursing community.

This transformative project was made possible by a \$1 million lead gift from longtime supporter Marilyn Clark and her son, Walt Jamros, whose generosity launched a \$1 million challenge that will shape our campus for years to come.

As we look toward the future, we are inspired by the impact we can achieve when faith, commitment, and collaboration come together, strengthening our mission today while preparing for the needs of tomorrow. MILESTONES

Christian Health launched an innovative SPRAVATO® (Esketamine) program for clients with treatment-resistant depression. This is the first hospital-based program of its kind in northern New Jersey.

The Council on Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey approved NewBridge Services as a treatment provider for problem gambling treatment. This service was expanded across Sussex, Morris, and Passaic Counties.

The Spring Gala honoring CEO Emeritus Douglas A. Struyk broke Christian Health's fundraising record, raising more than \$600,000.

LeadingAge New Jersey & Delaware nominated Christian Health's Andrew Van Orden to its board of trustees.

Christian Health broke ground on a patio renovation outside of Gracepoint Partial-Hospitalization and Intensive Outpatient Program, a project supported by a generous grant from The Bolger Foundation.

Windmere celebrated its 130th anniversary.

Christian Health was established in 1911 to provide compassionate mental health services for everyone, regardless of their ability to pay.

As the needs of our community changed, we expanded beyond our original inpatient behavioral-health setting to serve older adults and their families through a full continuum of senior living, and rehabilitation, as well as mental healthcare and community-based services for all ages.

Today, we continue this commitment and review client's unique circumstances to ensure they receive the care they need. Collectively in 2025, we provided the following services to our community.

Christian Health absorbed \$7,932,000 due to the unpaid cost of Medicaid, public programs, and other indigent-care programs.

\$2,295,000 of charity care was provided for residents, patients, and clients.

For the broader community, Christian Health participated in health fairs, presentations, and workshops; invited various organizations to utilize Christian Health meeting space; and joined efforts to improve neighborhoods' overall environments. These activities equated to \$85,000.
