

Do You Need Help Paying Your Energy Bills?

Representatives from the Home Energy and Weatherization Department will be available to explain the new application process, assist with applying and recertifying and answer any questions on Tuesday, September 23, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the Community Room.

The low-income home energy assistance program (LIHEAP & USF) offers financial assistance to those having difficulty paying their electric, gas, and deliverable fuel bills.

If you would like to apply or recertify please bring a copy of all pages of your lease including section 8 breakdown, your most recent PSEG bill, your 2025 social security award letter or proof of income/bank statements. If this is your first time applying please also bring your social security card. If you have any questions, you can call Susan Matyiku, Service and Activity Coordinator, at (201) 848-5837.

Please be advised that the application process for Home Energy Assistance (LIHEAP and USF) will be conducted strictly online. All submissions, forms, and required documents must be submitted through the official online portal. We are working closely with the Weatherization and Home Energy Division to help make this transition as smooth as possible. That said, This is a benefit provided by Passaic County, and it's important that residents take an active role in completing their applications to ensure they continue receive the assistance they are eligible for.
