

Welcome

Open visitation has resumed at Christian Health!

Pre-scheduled visitation is no longer required!

All visitors must enter through reception, complete a wellness screening, have their temperature taken, and wear a visitor's pass. If any COVID-19 symptoms are present, visitors will not be allowed to complete their visit. Masks MUST be worn by ALL visitors while in public areas indoors and outdoors. Gators or bandanas cannot be worn in place of masks. Wearing a well-fit mask, social distancing from those not in your visitation group while in ALL public indoor/outdoor spaces, and good hand hygiene are mandatory and vital to the health and well-being of those in our community.

- Informed consent from the visitor must be received at the time of screening. If you request a hard copy of the consent form, one will be provided to you.
- Indoor visits are permitted regardless of a resident's vaccination status as long as the community is not in the midst of an outbreak.
- Visits are restricted if a resident/patient is under quarantine or is COVID-19 positive.
- Visitors should be physically distant from other patients/residents that are not part of their group or "pod".
- Visitors are not allowed in a semi-private resident/patient room if they have not been vaccinated for COVID-19. No more than two vaccinated visitors are allowed in a resident/patient room at the same time.
- Visits for patients/residents who are in a semi-private room should not be held in the room, if avoidable.
- Residents with private rooms can have visitors in their room.
- Visitors are not permitted to enter a group activity room during their visit. If a resident receives a visitor, the resident may entertain a social visit with guests in a designated visitation area or private resident room, if appropriate.
- No entry is permitted into resident/patient dining areas while meals are being served.
- Visits in outdoor areas are permitted and encouraged for times of social visitation when the weather permits.
- Vaccinated residents may choose to unmask and/or eat with their vaccinated visitors while inside their private room. A designated lounge may be used for this purpose if resident resides in a semi-private/double room. [Not allowed in any outdoor/indoor public location].
- Vaccinated residents may choose to unmask during structured programs as long as ALL residents inside the room are vaccinated and may unmask while eating meals in the dining room without social distancing as long as ALL residents in the room are vaccinated. Staff will provide instruction for masking and social distancing if unvaccinated individuals are present. Table top barriers will remain in place for added safety.
- Visitation in public areas should be physically distanced between different groups regardless of vaccination status.
- If resident and visitor(s) are vaccinated, close contact without masks is permitted if alone in the resident's room.
- Beauty salon visits need to be scheduled. Please do not bring your loved one to the beauty salon for service without an appointment.
- When taking photos/videos of your loved one, please do not take photos/videos of other residents or team members without their explicit consent. Be mindful of anyone who may walk by when you are taking photos/videos. Please also refrain from taking photos/videos of areas where resident names may be displayed.
